with **ALEXANDER ZVEREV**

Zverev – Krajinovic 2-6, 7-5, 6-2

QUESTION: Congratulations for such a comeback. What brought you back when you were 2-5 down in the second set? And how are you feeling now after your win?

ZVEREV: I feel great. But I was trying to find ways the whole match. I was trying to get my rhythm back and my game going and it wasn't easy, I didn't play good at all in the first set and a half. Fortunately, I kind of started playing better and better the longer the match went and, you know, I broke him at 5-3 which was very important and the match kind of turned from there.

QUESTION: Yesterday, after our interview with you, Ivan Lendl announced the end of your relationship. So, I would like to know how was it and did you talk to each other yesterday?

ZVEREV: I mean, no. I mean I was a little surprised that he did it during the tournament which wasn't great. But look I have nothing but respect for him. We worked well for ten months and it's been very nice having him by my side, winning London. Obviously, I have great respect for him but you guys probably know as well, we both felt like we were going different directions. And, I wish him nothing but the best. I think he will find a player very soon. And it's also about personalities and maybe we didn't fit yet. Maybe it will change but for now it's over.

QUESTION: He is looking for another player maybe and what about you, are you looking for another coach or...?

ZVEREV: I have the greatest coach. I have the best coach there is. I am very happy with him – for now (laughs).
